During this period I've helped several companies to streamline and automate processes within their organisation. Together with the client; I'd sit down to define the problem that required solving. After that I'd sketch up the wireframes that would provide both a solution and a clear overview for the client. After which I'd be able to implement that solution as a PWA (together with a back-end developer) using the latest Angular framework and Material components.

In this way we've been able to roll out and maintain solutions for:

- A large warehouse operation; where we've built an application that fully automated the pick-order process, using a WebSocket connection and smartphones with a barcode scanner
- A BBQ-webshop; where we've automated the inbound process. Automating their weighing- and labeling setup.
- A start-up providing a QR-based item-tracking system. Allowing users to scan QR-stickers with their smartphones.
